

### **TASTE OF TUDOR HOUSE**



JEANETTE'S BEST BORSCHT


30 mL each butter and vegetable oil (2 Tosp)
3 onions, diced
2 garlic cloves
30 mL brown sugar (2 Tbsp)
1 kg beets, cooked, peeled and matchstick julienned (2 lb)
500 mL each celery and carrots, diced (2 cups)
50 mL red wine vinegar (1/4 cup)

Heat butter and oil in large pot over medium-high heat until bubbly. Add onions, garlic and quickly saute until soft. Add brown sugar, julienne beets. Celey, carrots, sinegar and cook for 5 minutes, stirring often. Add tomatoes, salt, pepper, chicken broth and bring to a simmer Partially cover pot and simmer for 1 hour. Add shredded cabbage and cook a further 30 minutes. Add sliced sausage (if desired) and simmer 15 minutes more. Stir in parsley and dill. Ladle sout pint bowks and add dollop of sour cream if desired. It tastes even better the second day!
