





TASTE OF TUDOR HOUSE

**JEANETTE'S BEST BORSCHT**

Jeanette Warren

30 mL each butter and vegetable oil (2 Tbsp)
 3 onions, diced
 2 garlic cloves
 30 mL brown sugar (2 Tbsp)
 1 kg beets, cooked, peeled and matchstick julienned (2 lb)
 500 mL each celery and carrots, diced (2 cups)
 50 mL red wine vinegar (1/4 cup)

1 can whole tomatoes and juice
 10 mL salt (2 tsp)
 5 mL pepper (1 tsp)
 2 L chicken broth (8 cups)
 500 g cabbage, shredded (1 lb)
 500 g farmers sausage, cut in large pieces (1 lb)
 15 mL each dill and parsley, chopped (1 Tbsp)

Heat butter and oil in large pot over medium-high heat until bubbly. Add onions, garlic and quickly saute until soft. Add brown sugar, julienne beets, celery, carrots, vinegar and cook for 5 minutes, stirring often. Add tomatoes, salt, pepper, chicken broth and bring to a simmer. Partially cover pot and simmer for 1 hour. Add shredded cabbage and cook a further 30 minutes. Add sliced sausage (if desired) and simmer 15 minutes more. Stir in parsley and dill. Ladle soup into bowls and add dollop of sour cream if desired. It tastes even better the second day!
