

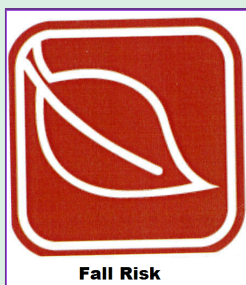
We are trending under National and WRHA

SAFETY TIP OF THE MONTH

UNIVERSAL FALLS PRECAUTION LOGO

If you see this logo in a Resident room Tudor House has completed a fall risk assessment and an individualized care plan has been implemented to mitigate the risk.

Some general tips include:

- Call bell within reach
- Bed in low position (brakes locked)
- Lighting appropriate to resident needs
- Good fitting, non-slip, enclosed footwear/pillow paw socks
- Urinal/bedpan/commode within reach/at bedside
- Furniture positioned to facilitate safe resident access
- Ambulating device close to resident (brakes on)



Pillow Paws Socks

Socks that have grip on the bottom and fits under normal footwear. The socks prevents residents from slipping or falling.

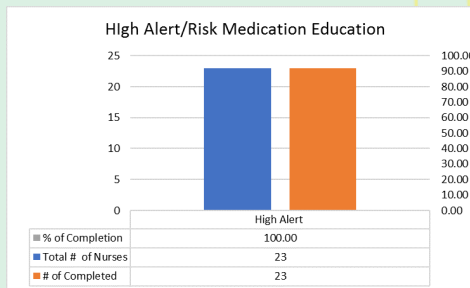


Accreditation Required Organization Practice (ROP)

Medication Management Standards for Community Based Organizations

Tudor House collaborated with the IERHA & Pharmacist to create an action plan which resulted heightened medication safety practices for nurses to complete independent double checks for high alert/risk medications. Tudor House Nurses attended an education session and completed a competency quiz to address high alert/risk medications with a focus on the

importance of completing independent double checks without prompting from a co nurse.

LTCAM Annual Provincial Conference & Exhibition

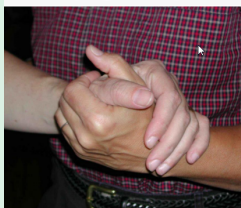
13 Tudor House Staff from the various departments attended the LTCAM Conference.

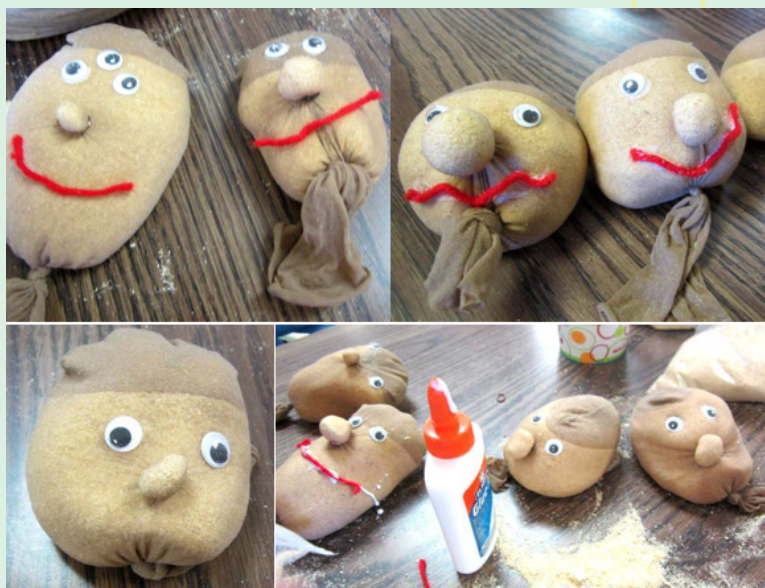

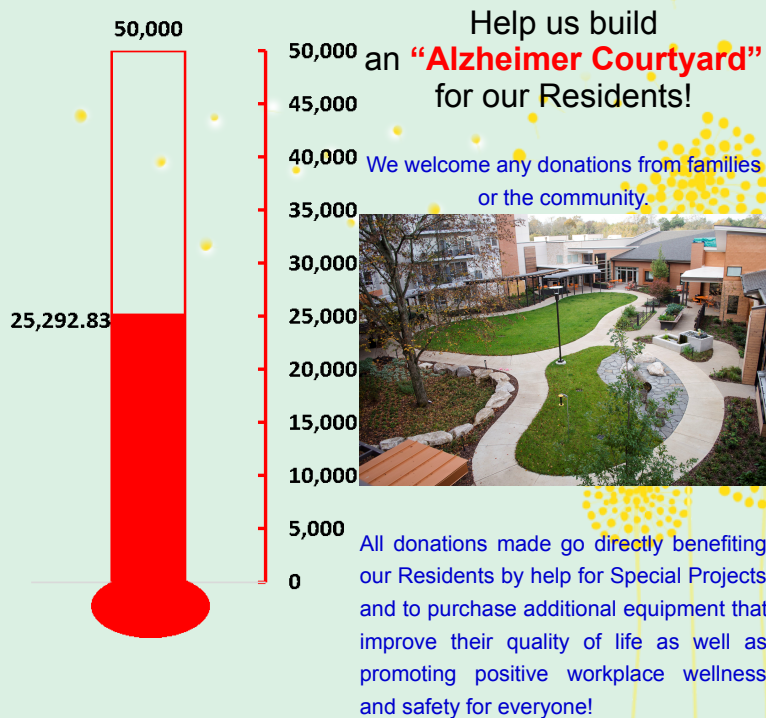
